Roundup of AIIMS, Nagpur for the month of August 2025.

I. Hospital Services :--

- Total patients attended in OPD : 41,582
- IPD Admissions : 2,762
- Major surgeries performed : 960
- Patients attended in Trauma & Emergency : OPD - 2,084; IPD : 359
- Transplants : Kidney : 01 (Live related transplant)

II. Workshops, Training & Events :

- The Capacity Building Unit of AIIMS, Nagpur under Mission Karmayogi had successfully organized 26 sessions from **1st August 2025 to 28th August 2025** for imparting the “**Rashtriya Karmayogi Large Scale Jan Sewa Programme**” to regular employees (faculty, non-faculty and nursing cadre) of the Institute by certified in house 52 Master Trainers.
- The **Department of Rheumatology and Clinical Immunology** in collaboration with the **Department of General Medicine** organized a one day Rheumatology Quiz and CME titled “**RHEUMINATE 2025**” on **2nd August 2025**.
- **College of Nursing** in collaboration with the **Department of Pediatrics and Neonatology** organized a World Breastfeeding Awareness Programme on **6th August 2025** as part of Breastfeeding awareness week in front of pediatric OPD, AIIMS Nagpur. The **World Breastfeeding Week 2025** with the theme “Prioritize Breast feeding: Create Sustainable Support System” was also celebrated from **1st August to 7th August 2025** with various events to highlight the importance of breastfeeding among all stakeholders.



- The **Art of Living foundation** conducted a free 45 minute session on **Mental Health Awareness & Meditation** on **8th August 2025** at AIIMS Nagpur.
- The **College of Nursing** in collaboration with **Association of Nurse Executives (India)** hosted a 7 day CNE titled “**Leading Safe Care, Essential for Nursing Manager**” from **8th August 2025 to 14th August 2025**. The course aimed to equip the participants from various prestigious institutions across India to confidently implement global safety standards and drive quality improvements.

- The **Department of Microbiology** successfully organized a 2 day hands on workshop on **19th- 20th of August 2025** on **“PCR Precision: Mastering RT-PCR Technique”** emphasizing the pivotal role of molecular diagnostics in public health.



- The **Department of Community Medicine** conducted a workshop on Grant Writing for Faculty and Senior Residents on **29th -30th August, 2025**.
- The **Department of Community Medicine** organized a workshop on **“Protocol Development for Systematic Review and Meta-analysis”** through the Technical Resource Centre (Centre for Evidence based Guidelines) for the AIIMS Faculty on **31st August 2025**.

III. New facilities/courses introduced :

- The **Department of Community Medicine** launched the **1st PG Certificate Course in Infectious Disease Modelling** from **30th July 2025 to 2nd August 2025**. The course aimed to strengthen India’s epidemic preparedness by training 20 public health researchers.



- The **Department of Ophthalmology** on **7th August 2025** inaugurated the Alternative Refraction Room equipped with Digital charts, Trial sets and frames.



IV. Remarkable Milestones :

- On the occasion of World Organ donation Day, **AIIMS, Nagpur** was awarded by **NOTTO, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India** as the best **“Emerging Government Institution in Organ Donation and Transplant”**. The award was presented at the hands of Hon’ble Union Health Minister, Shri J.P.Nadda to the Executive Director and CEO, AIIMS, Nagpur.



- **AIIMS, Nagpur** was also conferred with three prestigious awards by the **Regional cum State Organ and Tissue Transplant Organisation (ROTTO-SOTTO), Western Region and Maharashtra** in recognition of the institute’s exemplary contributions to organ donation and transplantation. The 03 awards include Certificate of Appreciation & Recognition for **Best Brain Stem Death Team, Public Sector Hospital contributing to the Organ Transplant and Special Award to a State Hospital for the efficient revival of the Deceased Organ Donation Program** in Maharashtra.

The ceremony was held during the Organ Donation Day programme held at KEM Hospital, Mumbai, in presence of Minister of Public Health and Family Welfare, Prakashrao Abtikar.

This achievement was made possible with the visionary leadership and continuous support of Executive Director and Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Prof (Dr) Prashant P Joshi, whose guidance has been instrumental in advancing AIIMS Nagpur's mission of promoting ethical and impactful organ donation practices in the region.

A remarkable milestone
ON OCCASION of Indian Organ Donation Day, AIIMS Nagpur

has been awarded by NOTTO, Minister of Health and Family Welfare MOHFW, Government of India as the best 'Emerging Government Institution in Organ Donation and Transplant' under the able guidance and support of Executive Director (Prof) Dr Prashant Joshi. The award was presented to him at Delhi at the hands of Minister J P Nadda. AIIMS-N has successfully performed 46 kidney transplants, including 32 from deceased donor patients and 14 from live donors. AIIMS is the 3rd institution in the country to perform donation after circulatory death and the first in Maharashtra and first among all AIIMS. 12 bone marrow transplants (Dr Khushoo) and 25 corneal transplants (Dr Puja Bang) were also done at AIIMS. The team members include Dr Anand Chellapan, Dr Amol Bhawane, Department of Urology, (Dr Munjewar) Department Neurosurgery, (Dr Alok Umredkar) Anaesthesia, (Dr Chauhan, Dr Sacheta-Meshram) Paediatric Surgery, GI Surgery, biochemistry, Pathology, Radiology and nuclear medicine, Trauma and Emergency Medicine, (Dr Mahendra Chauhan) Microbiology, Hospital infection control team (Dr Meena Mishra), Brain Stem Death team (Dr Rajashree Khot), MJPJAY/PMJAY Team, Forensic Medicine, Competent Authority Cell, Administration and MS office Team (Dr Nagdeve, Dr Marathe, Dr Animesh, Dr Bounak Dubey) and Nodal officer Dr Manish Shrivastava for their constant efforts and hard work.
